## **Negotiation Update**

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA) asked through our lawyer for a list of key concerns with the current proposed License. Rather than get into the minutia of every clause we summarized the key issues as follows:

- 1. Tenured docks, boat houses, boat ramps and all other encroachments need to be grandfathered.
- 2. License needs to have continuance with no expiration.
- 3. Transferability of license to and encroachments / improvements to future purchaser.
- 4. License fees need to be capped and in line with other jurisdictions.
- 5. Termination of license can only be with reasonable cause.
